SCHOOL SATISFACTION AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

The pupils must always:

- with their behaviour have respect for other pupils, teachers, school staff, school car drivers and visitors in the school
- to take care of school property and school area property and compensate for the damage they have caused
- keep good order and observe accurately orders that are given to them and do their homework conscientiously
- stay outside during the breaks unless anything else is informed
- stay in school area during school time
- remember that skiing, sliding downhill, cycling and using other equipments is allowed only in particular places

To throw snowballs, stones or other objects, that can cause damage, is forbidden. To stay at the skateboard ramp or close to it is forbidden between 8.00 am to 15.15 pm.

The pupil is not allowed, without teacher's or the meeting of teachers' permission, to stay away from morning opening, from lesson/lessons or rehearsals for any other reason than illness. Absence because of illness must immediately be informed to the class teacher.

According to the Finnish law all cyclists have to wear a helmet.

The pupil can get a permission for absence by supporter's request:

- for one lesson from the teacher concerned
- at the most for two days from the form master
- at the most for two weeks from the head master
- a longer absence must be applied for education board in good time before absence

The pupil has to take care of that unmade exercises will be made.

The pupil is not allowed to bring candies or something else to school that can disturb common school order. Money and valuable articles must not be taken to school. School doesn't cover the lost property.

If the pupil breaks the school rules following reprimands and punishment can, according to the school law, be used:

- doing one's homework after the end of a school day
- removal from the class room for the time that is left for the lesson
- detention at the most for two hours
- home reminder
- written warning
- suspension from school at the most for three months

These regulations are made and accepted by school staff on the 19th of August 2004.
